

## **BIOGRAPHY OF DR NICK BROUGHTON, CHIEF EXECUTIVE SOUTHERN HEALTH**



Nick joined Southern Health NHS Nick is a psychiatrist by background and has worked as a Consultant in Forensic Psychiatry since 2000. He graduated from Cambridge University in 1989 and completed his medical training at St. Thomas' Hospital Medical School. He trained in psychiatry in North West London. During the course of his consultant career he has worked in a wide variety of secure settings including a specialist remand service, an enhanced medium secure service for women, a remand prison and a young offenders' institution.

He has also been Clinical Director for a forensic service and Medical Director of a large specialist mental health Trust. He was joint Clinical Director and Co-Chair of London's Strategic Clinical Network for Mental Health and a Director of Imperial College Health Partners.
